


We will post homework and communicate via Google Classroom. Your classroom logins have been shared.


Your children will have logins for several applications.

Attendance




- Clear link between attendance, attainment and wellbeing

- We want all our pupils to enjoy 'life in abundance'.


Behaviour & Relationships



E-safety - children




- A new AUP has been sent to your email, please read and sign!




